This term we are learning about things that move and how they move. We will be looking at transport and at ourselves. Thinking how the athletes use their bodies to move and how we can travel around the World.

Week One This week we will be learning about how we move on the roads. We will read 'Mrs Armitage's Bike' and 'Farmer Duck'. We will look at how we can move on our feet and what else we can use, such as bikes and cars. We will make simple graphs about how many cars and other vehicles we see on our road. And write our own stories about our Armitage Bikes.

Week Two This week we will be learning about moving in Space. We will be spacemen and visit other planets. We will read 'Aliens Love Underpants' and make our own funny stories. We will count pants, look at patterns on pants and make our own alien pants!

Week Three & Week Four We will be enjoying lots of workshops and lots of creative activities during our creative weeks. In addition we will be looking at the Olympics and making our own Carnival celebrations. More information will be given nearer the time.

Week Five We will be looking at moving by rail. We will read 'The Train Ride', 'Getting to Grandad Bears' and look at the Train Ride video. We will write our own train poems to perform. And we will have to solve problems at the train station for maths. e.g. how many passengers can board the train?

Week Six We will be learning about how to move on water. We will look at Pirates and read lots of Pirate stories. We will make our own pirate maps and follow a map to find some treasure!

Week Seven We will be looking at how we move in the air. We will read 'The Blue Balloon' and investigate how we can make our parachute peg person fly in the air. We will look at aeroplanes and where we can travel to. We will look at maps and where other countries are.
