CLASS ROUTINES

- Please ensure your child brings a coat to school everyday too. The weather is very changeable at the moment and we always aim to go out at playtimes and lunchtimes
- Also please ensure all clothing is named especially school sweatshirts and cardigans
- Please send a drink bottle with WATER only

Staff also request please **TRY AND HEAR YOUR CHILD READ** as often as you can. It really is vital in developing their reading even further! The more they read the more they progress and become confident readers.
