Dear Parents / Guardians of Reception & Nursery children,

### **START and END OF THE SCHOOL DAY**

Please ensure your child is in school and ready for registration at 8.50am. The school doors open at 8.40am and the register is taken at 8.50am; any child arriving after this time will receive a late mark. Ideally children should be in school by 8.45am so they can take part in 'morning work' and then be ready for the day ahead. There is no need to remain in the classroom now as children are well settled into the routines.

Please use the side entrance door into our EYFS unit as this door is staffed; please refrain from using the back entrance as due to staffing levels this door cannot be supervised. Thank you.

### **SUPERVISION at the START and END OF THE SCHOOL DAY**

Parents are responsible for their children at the start and end of the day when on the playground. Please ensure you watch your child if they play on the balancing beam or climbing frame. Also if your child needs the toilet after they have left at the end of the day please bring them to the main toilets - **do not let them urinate in the grass / garden area.**

At the end of the day can I request parents leave the playground as soon as possible as we now have after school clubs using the playground. Thank you.

### **GOLDEN TIME**

Golden Time on a Friday is one of our key incentives in school. All children are eligible to Golden Time (40 minutes of 'free' choice time on a Friday afternoon) however if they lose Golden Time for some reason they come along to the school office for the time they have lost. The children are fully aware of the rules in school and of our expectations of behaviour.

The vast majority of children never lose Golden Time and after discussion the staff have decided that for the rest of this school year, if a child loses Golden Time a text will be sent to parents to inform them. We hope you will support us by talking to your child as to why they've lost Golden Time. Also please feel free to phone school or talk to your child's class teacher.
