HEAD LICE

Some children seem to have a recurring issue with head lice; despite the fact that their parents regularly monitor their hair and treat when required. Three mums have been to see me and are particularly upset about this issue. Therefore can I reiterate the importance of regularly checking your child's hair and if your child has head lice treat immediately. Children do not have time off school for head lice but if you need to treat them please do and bring your child into school later that day. Also if we do 'spot' head lice we will phone so you can collect your child and treat. We do not 'inspect' children's hair; but remain vigilant for symptoms such as lots of head scratching etc. Please read the flyer on the back of this letter and talk to your pharmacist for advice on treatment of head lice. We ALL need to be vigilant therefore PLEASE CHECK YOUR CHILD'S HAIR THIS WEEKEND.

FIDGET SPINNERS

There is a trend for fidget spinners at the moment. Please leave these toys at home for the evening or weekend. School policy is that children do not bring toys into school only when asked to do so or on special occasions.
