Here are the workshops/activities your child will be involved in - please talk to them and reiterate the important safety messages:

Monday 5th June

WATER SAFETY - Y1 & Y2 children learnt about the dangers around water through an assembly.

HEALTH SAFETY - Hannah, a nurse came and talked about her job and ways nurses help us and keep us safe. She spoke to all main school children.

Tuesday 6th June

ROAD SAFETY - DCC Road Safety department have been talking to the children and they have taken part in activities and workshops related to road safety.

Wednesday 7th June

FIRE SAFETY - our Y2 children will have a workshop with our local Fire Prevention Education Officer. Other children will learn about the dangers of fire and how to stay safe.

BIKE SAFETY - EYFS children can bring their bikes/tricycles to school. Don't forget their helmets!

Thursday 8th June

Y2, Y1 and some Reception children will take part in '**FLAT STAN**' **First Aid Workshops**. Our PFA having kindly offered to pay for these workshops.

Friday 9th June

DRESS UP DAY! Dress as someone who helps to keep us safe; and explain what they do and why their job is so important.

BIKEABILITY - level 1 - our Y2 children will be taking part in this workshop funded by Chesterfield Schools Sports Partnership. Further details to follow.
